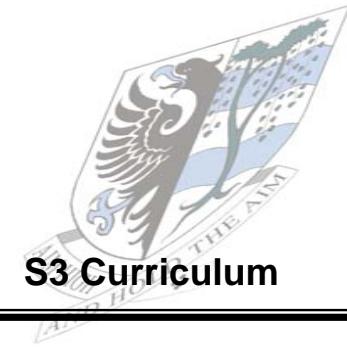
Subjects *generally* grouped into 'modes', maintain **Breadth**
