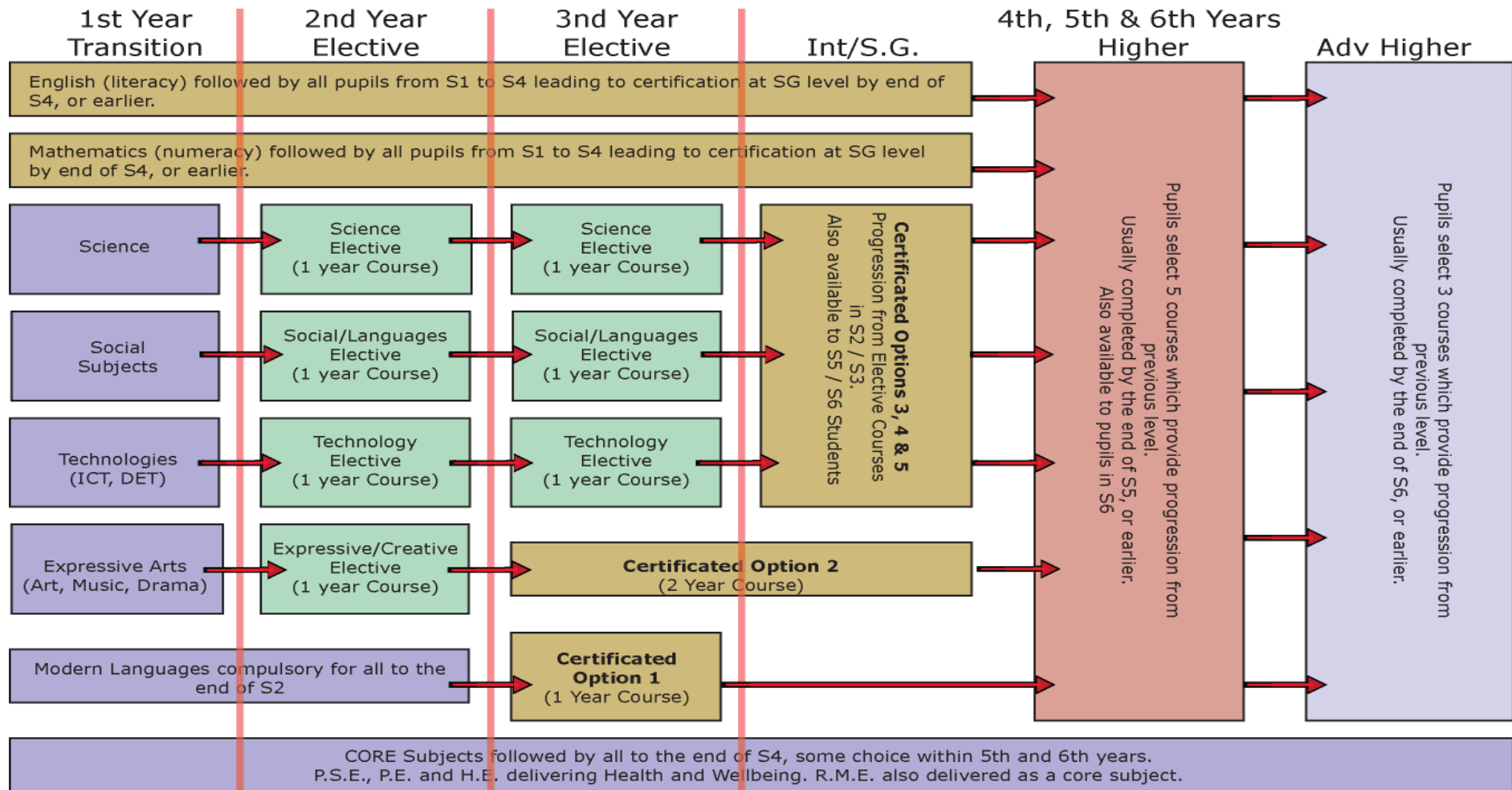

S1 going in to S2 – ‘new’ S2

- Columns 1-4 and top half of preference form.
- Select electives within modes.
- Also select in columns 1-3 in bottom half for S3 (reviewed next year).
- Column 4 elective leads to two year SQA course presented at end of S4 2014 (reviewed next year).

S2 going in to S3 – ‘new’ S3

- Review selection columns 1-3 from last year – check modes.
- Column 4 – two year SQA course presented at end of S4 (2013) 3 periods per week.
- Column 5 – one year SQA course presented at end of S3 (2012) 5 periods per week.
